First of all lets read from **Matthew 24:** beginning at verse **3** to See what Jesus Himself predicted would take place at the time of His Parousia or Personal Presence. I will read through what he says, and then list them for our understanding.

Matthew 24:3 *"And as He sat in the mount of Olives, The disciples came unto Him privately, saying, tell us, when shall these things be? And what shall be the sign of Thy "Parousia" (Presence) and of the end of the world?"*

This is no 1. vs 3 The question was asked, "what will be the signs of thy Parousia? Now, that means this question is what will it be like, what are the signs of thy presence, thy great

appearing before Thy coming. That is what the question is, they wanted to know what this great time will be like. So first of all there will have to be a great parousia of Christ, this time when His presence will be here in such a way that it has never been before. That is the first sign. His Presence will be here.

4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.

2. **vs 4** Take heed no man deceives you, this time of His Parousia will be great time deception, He said “the time of the great parousia, the great Presence will be a time that every man will try to deceive you. He said, “*take heed that no man deceive you*”. It begins with religion, the Word, God Himself will be put out of the churches, it will be a time where ***He is standing at the door of the church knocking***, “behold I am standing at the door knocking, trying to gain entrance, And since Jesus told us His Word will judge in the Last Days we see that “***Behold the judge standeth at the door knocking.***” Then Prayer will be taken out of the Schools, And His Ten commandments will be taken away from the capital buildings, and God will not be allowed in public life, that Means His presence will be spurned everywhere, and Even the name will be removed from the DNC’s platform as it was in 2008. 3. **vs 5** False Anointed ones so the great deception begins in the church but then move into education, courthouses, the capital buildings, media, and medicine by first putting God outside. You see these are the beginnings of the signs and events with constitute His great presence is here. He comes down in 1909 then these signs and events al begin until in 1933 he begins showing Himself that He is here and if you look at How he is removed from all aspects of life this shows the great deception begins.

6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. 7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom:

I have this as number 4. But it really should have been number 4 and 5. Thus making the total 85 and not 84. Thus we have and are witnessing 80 of the 85 signs and events because wars are what happens and rumors of war are what is going to happen. **vs 6** speaks of *Wars and rumors of wars*. But let's look at the first thing. Wars. We have had since 1909. Beginning with WWI, then WWII, then in the late 40's war in Myanmar, then in the 50's the Korean war, then in the 60's war in Columbia, Venezuela and Ecuador.

Then in the 70's War in Ethiopia, then the Vietnam war, , in the 90's the Falkland Island wars between England and Argentina, and then in the early 2000's war in Nigeria, Niger, Burkina Faso, Mali, Benin, Togo, Algeria, Tunisia, Chad, Ivory Coast, Ghana, Mauritania, then the war between the Hutu's and Tutsi's in Congo, Rwanda and Uganda, Burundi,

Mexico, Boko Haram in Cameroon, then in the 2010's Syria, Nigeria, Mali, Yemen, Dessert storm in Saudi Arabia, and then the War in Somalia in the 90's if Afghanistan, the Khurdish wars, Yemen wars, Indo-Pakistani wars, Israeli-Palestinian war, and finally the war in Ukraine between Russia and Ukraine.

Then we come to no 5 rumors of war and we are hearing daily in the news that Russia is getting their missiles ready for WWII. When will this happen" It has already begun in fledgling skirmishes between Russia and Ukraine, and NATO and the USA. Then Armageddon which we will be gone for. So we have listed no 4 as wars, 5 as rumors of war, the 6 nation shall rise against nation, and 7 kingdom against Kingdom, and finally no 8

***and there shall be** no 8 **famines**, which we see everywhere in the third world countries, such as Malawi, Mozambique, Let me just give you a list.*

1930–1931 Famine Madagascar 32,000

The Foreign Office representative at Army High Command 6 noted on 25.03.1942 that according to reports reaching municipal authorities at least 50 people were dying of hunger every day, and that the true number might be much higher as in many cases the cause of death was stated as "unknown" and besides many deaths were not reported. According to Soviet sources about 70–80,000 people died of starvation in Kharkov during the occupation by Nazi Germany. [Soviet Union](#) 11,918–80,000

1941-1943 Famine in [Kyiv](#) (Kiev). On April 1, 1942, well after the first winter of famine, Kiev officially had about 352,000 inhabitants.

In the middle of 1943—more than four months before the end of German rule—the city officially had about 295,600. Death by starvation was not the only reason for the rapid decline in population: deportation to Germany and Nazi shootings also played their part.

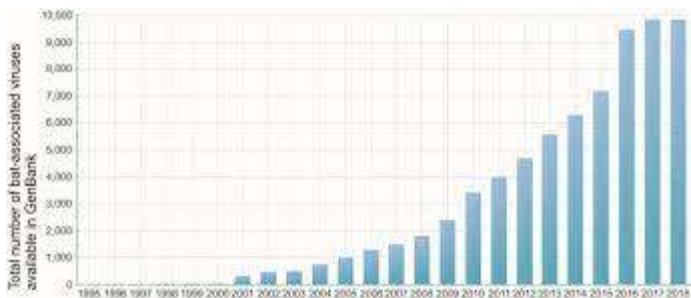
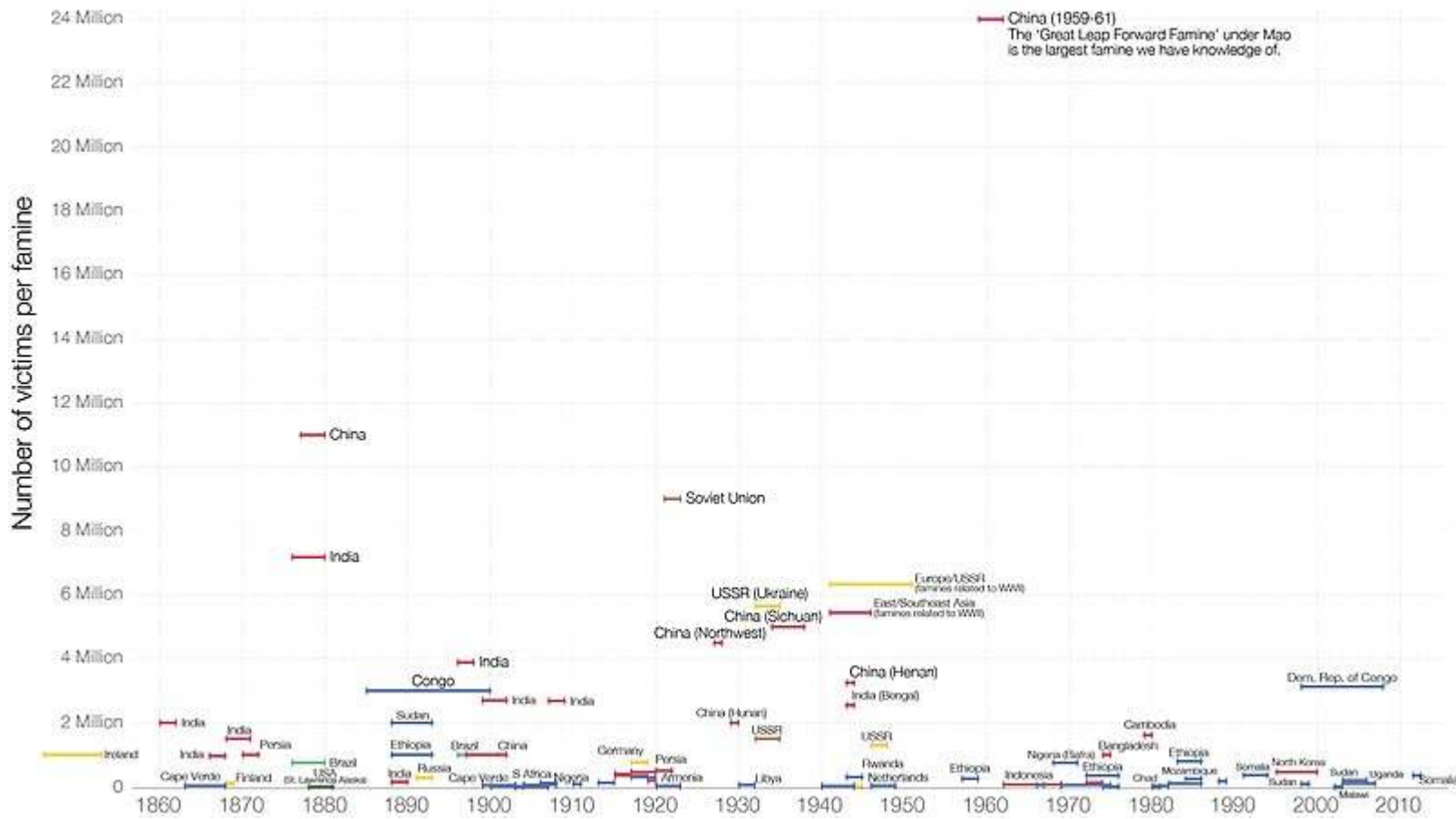

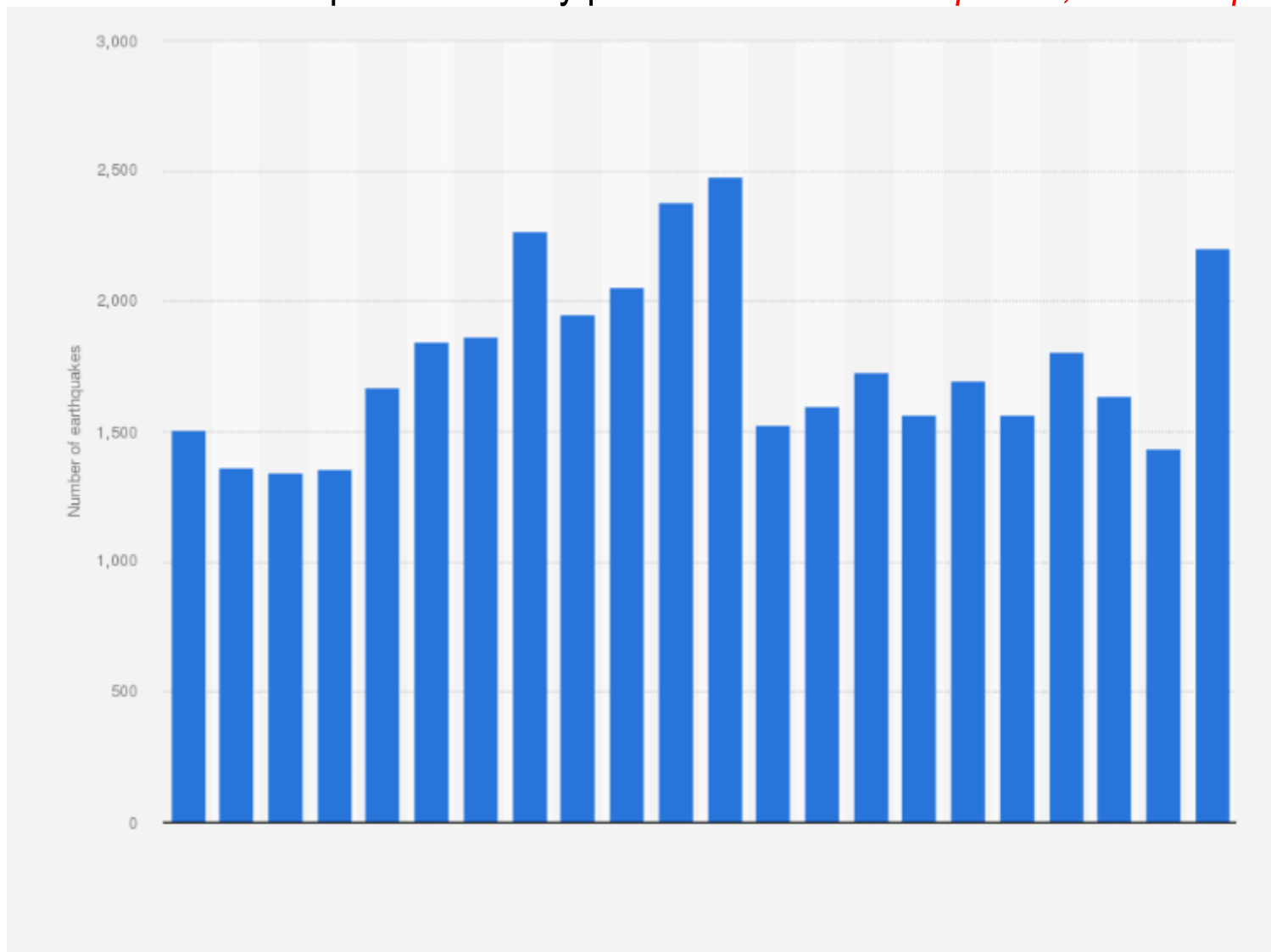

Christians were killed for The amount of people who were persecuted for their faith last year. More than 2,100 churches were attacked or closed.

More than 124,000 Christians were forcibly displaced from their homes because of their faith, and almost 15,000 became refugees.

Sub-Saharan Africa—the epicenter of global Christianity—is now also the epicenter of violence against Christians, as Islamist extremism has spread well beyond Nigeria.

And North Korea is back at No. 1, according to the [2023 World Watch List](#) (WWL), the latest annual accounting from Open Doors of the top 50 countries where it is most dangerous and difficult to be a Christian.

The concerning tallies of martyrdoms and church attacks are actually lower than in last year's report. But Open Doors emphasizes they are “an absolute minimum figure,” and is quick to note the data decline does not suggest real improvements in religious freedom.

For example, the reduction in church closures was “due in large part” to Chinese officials having closed almost 7,000 churches over the prior two years. And the drop of Afghanistan from No. 1 last year to No. 9 this year “offers little cheer” because it's driven by how most Afghan Christians “went deep into hiding or fled overseas” after the Taliban's takeover.

Overall, and same as last year, 360 million Christians live in nations with high levels of persecution or discrimination. That's 1 in 7 Christians worldwide, including 1 in 5 believers in Africa, 2 in 5 in Asia, and 1 in 15 in Latin America.

And for only the third time in three decades of tracking, all 50 nations scored high enough to register “very high” persecution levels on Open Doors’ matrix of more than 80 questions. So did 5 more nations that fell just outside the cutoff.

Islamic extremism continues to cause the most persecution (31 nations), especially in sub-Saharan Africa where Open Doors fears Nigeria will soon trigger “a vast humanitarian catastrophe” across the continent. Researchers also noted how China has increased digital restrictions and surveillance and is “forging a network of nations seeking to redefine human rights—away from universal standards and religious freedoms.” And a fourth Latin American country, Nicaragua, entered the list as authoritarian governments increasingly view Christians as voices of opposition.

The purpose of the annual WWL rankings—which have chronicled how North Korea has competition as persecution gets worse and worse—is to guide prayers and to aim for more effective anger while showing persecuted believers that they are not forgotten.

The 2023 version tracks the time period from October 1, 2021, to September 30, 2022, and is compiled from grassroots reports by more than 4,000 Open Doors workers across more than 60 countries.

Today's report also marks 30 years of the list, first created in 1993 after the Iron Curtain fell. What has Open Doors learned?

First, it's clear that persecution continues to worsen. The number of countries hitting the WWL threshold to be tracked has risen from 40 in 1993 to 76 today, and the average country score has gone up 25 percent.

In short, the persecuted church has taught Open Doors the truth of 1 Corinthians 12:26: "If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it."

Where are Christians most persecuted today?

Afghanistan does not represent the only substantial change in this year's rankings. Cuba moved to No. 27, up from No. 37, due to the intensification of repressive tactics against Christian leaders and activists opposing Communist principles. Prior to widespread demonstrations in 2021, it didn't even rank. Burkina Faso moved to No. 23, up from No. 32, due to increased jihadist activity, exacerbated by similar instability in neighboring Sahel nations. Mozambique moved to No. 32, up from No. 41, due to Islamic militancy in its northern

region. And Colombia moved to No. 22, up from No. 30, due to targeted violence against Christians by criminal gangs.

Comoros joined the list at No. 42, rising 11 spots due to increased government paranoia (only foreigners there are allowed religious freedom). And Nicaragua joined the list for the first time, rising 11 spots to No. 50 due to growing dictatorial repression, especially against the Roman Catholic Church.

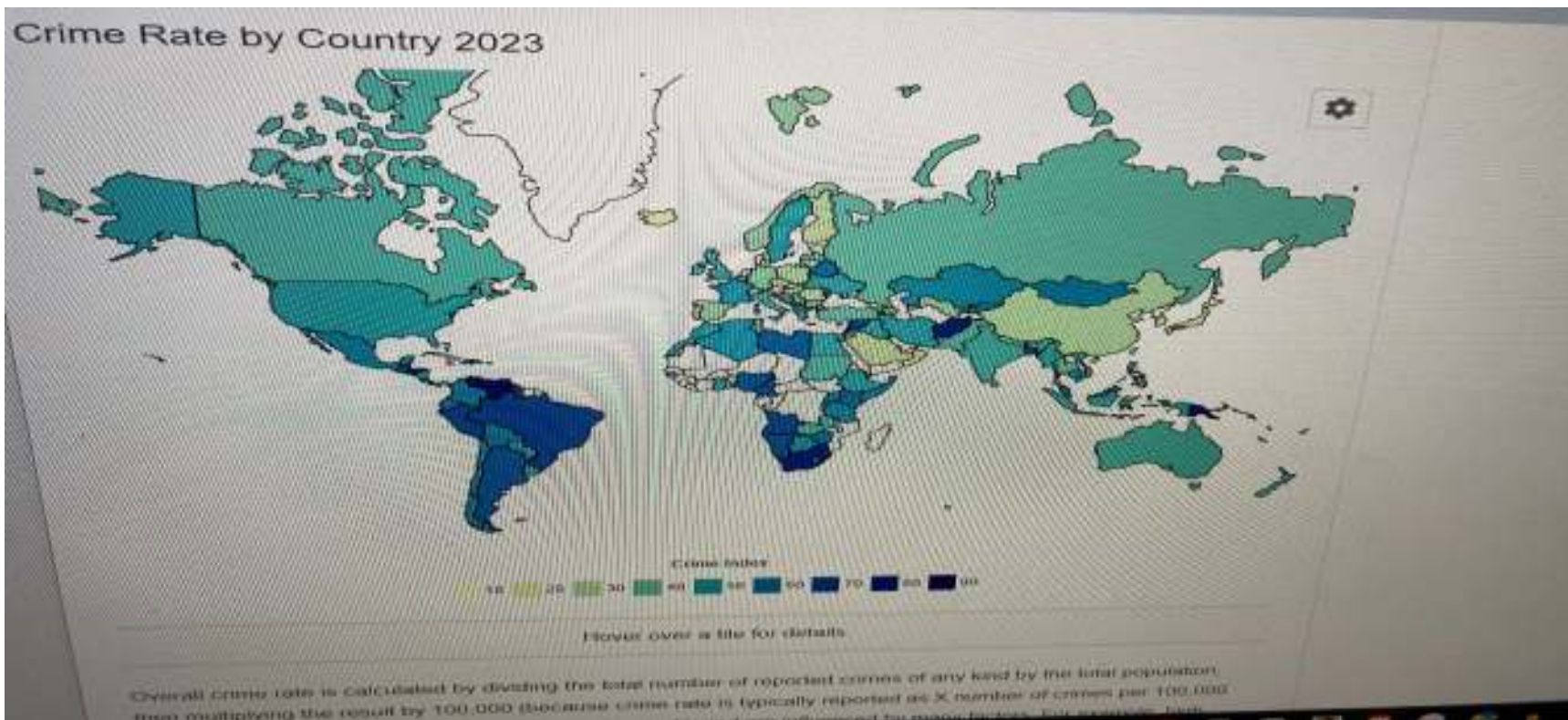
