Now, of course, it's not my message, it's His message. But we do have questions and answers this morning from the ministers, and we'll just get right to it.

Quotation for Question No. 1: How Can I Overcome - 63-0825 1M Sooner or later we're going to have to give each other up. But that won't hurt the rapture now. See? No. **They come first then**.

Them are privileged that's gone on. (So, Brother Don is a privileged person.) They come first, See, "we which are alive and remain to the coming of the Lord will not hinder or prevent those that are asleep."

"The trumpet of God shall sound, and the dead in Christ shall rise first." Then when our eyes behold our loved ones, then we'll be changed in a moment in a twinkling of an eye, and with them shall be caught up together. Now, this is one quote.

Now, again he says we have quote number two from: Going Beyond The Camp - 64-0719 2E ... Oh, my! "And the trump of God shall sound, and the dead in Christ shall rise first, appear to many." And all at once you happen to stand and look, and "Well, there's a brother..."

And you know it ain't long. In a few minutes we'll be changed in a moment in a twinkling of an eye, and together with them be missing on earth, caught up to meet the Lord in the air.

In the first two quotes, the prophet is showing that our changes, comes after seeing the dead being raised up.

But consider what he stated in the following quote, where he's showing that we see the resurrected after being changed. Now, this is a question. So the quote is.

Questions & Answers - 64-0823 1M ... And then we'll all get together. And when they begin to get together, then we which are alive and remain shall be changed.

These mortal bodies will not see death, but just of a sudden, there'll be like a sweep go over us, and you're changed. You're turned back like Abraham was, from an old man to a young man, from an old woman to a young woman.

What's this sudden change? And after while you're traveling like a thought, and you can see those then who are already resurrected.

Question No. 1: How can you make the 2 first quotes line up with the third one?

Because it appears, you see them after, and in the first two quotes, you see them before. In the first two quotes, he definitely says, we get together and we see our loved ones in the midst.

But in the last one, he states, he says, after we get together. So how do you know you have gotten together?

Then he tells us how that change will come. He says, and you can see those then who are already resurrected. So seeing them is not the catalyst for the change, but the change makes you understand who it is that you are already gathered with. Notice again, after we get together, see, he says, first of all, he says, in the second...

Let me just go back to his quote here. And then we'll all get together. So think about that. How are we going know we're getting together? Huh? How do you know that you're getting together? Maybe you won't see them with your eyes, but you surely feel their presence, because he says, and then we'll all get together, and when they begin to get together, then we which are alive and remain, shall be changed. So it's not the seeing them that brings on our change. It's the sweep that comes over us that brings our change.

Answer to Question No. 1. It does not look like he is saying differently to me, it all depends on how you are reading what he says here.

In the first two quotes, he definitely says we get together, and we see our loved ones in our midst but in the last one he also says, "after we get together". So how do you know

you have gotten together? Because it's a statement, after we get together. How you going to know that?

Then he tells us how that change will come. He says then you can see them who are already resurrected.

So, the seeing them is not the catalyst for the change, but the change makes you understand who it is that you are already gathered together with.

And we'll remember our acquaintance and the ones that's been there. And there'll be many there that we didn't even think would be there, (So you're looking for Charlie. I could say this. You don't have to look at him to know his presence. All right. You've lived how many years together? 53 years together. You ought to know when you're sleeping with the right man. In other words, you know, there's something about the person that you know them, even without seeing them.) for you know it's at that time that I believe that the bread that we have cast upon the human troubled waters will return to us, on that day.

When we see the effects of our testimony on people that we didn't understand their actions towards it, will probably be there. What a day that will be! So that gives you hope.

And then the seeds that we sowed not even thinking what they would do, but here they are. They brought forth precious fruits and we'll see them on that day.

Then as we see Him...and we'll not be as we are now. We'll know how to love Him more. We'll not stand back with a little fear, because we'll be like Him. He'll be more of a relative to us than He is now. In other words, you call Him Brother, right? But you'll see Him as Brother. You'll recognize Him more as a relative to us than He is now.

We'll understand Him better, because we're so far away in the mortal bodies. Then we'll have a body like His glorious body. We'll know how to worship Him.

And when we see what the Presence of His Being has done to us, (change us so see, presence of the body, then change, right?) changed us, the old back young, all the deformed straightened out, oh, we'll understand then why His power healed us.

So it's not someday the resurrection takes place and you look around and see all these people. Then you get your change. No, you get your change and you see them. All right. Now, you might be aware that they're in a dimension just outside your curtain, so to speak, but you won't see them until you get your change.

The questions that's been in our mind, "How can He do it? What would this?" somehow, mysteriously, they'll all fade away. The knots that's been tied in the back of our minds, "Will it be this? How could it be?"

Somehow, or another, majestic fingers will just untangle, unravel those knots, and it'll all fade into the one big crown of love.

You know what's going to happen? You know what's going to untie everything for you, is when God brings to pass His word. In other words, when God manifests His word, He

interprets it. Then the question is over.

So, as I said, the catalyst is not seeing them that have passed on before. Otherwise, the first half of the resurrection that was witnessed by 500 in the book of Acts would have gotten their change by seeing the resurrected ones. But the Light of His Glorious presence is the catalyst.

Remember, 500 witnesses to the resurrection 2000 years ago, that didn't change them. So we get our change when His sweep comes over us, His presence, we come into His presence. Like, I know several people that actually were walking into the presence of Brother Branham when the angel of the Lord was standing there.

And they said about 8ft from Brother Branham's body stood the angel of the Lord. And you could actually feel that presence so strong that they remember it today. And that's 50 some years ago. Actually, it's more than that. It's about 60 some years ago. So anyway, we're looking for just the fulfillment of God's word.

Scripture for Question No. 2: In Who is this Melchizedek series No.102, Matthew 27: 52 And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, 53 And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

Notice that Jesus cried with a Loud Voice and the graves opened, and the saints which slept arose, but notice that they did not come forth as resurrected beings **until He came forth**. So, the order of the resurrection is a very important thing. Now, he's quoting a sermon that I preached, okay?

Question No. 2: Who will be the first fruits in the Omega ministry, and how?

Answer to question No. 2: From the sermon, not the book, He said Seven Church Ages 54-0512 "Behold He cometh with clouds." Now, let me stop here just a moment. Clouds doesn't mean that He's coming on a big thunderhead as mama, bless her heart she's sitting here somewhere.

I remember her voice, she used to set and tell me, said, He's coming on a great big cloud, gonna raise someday and God's gonna come on.

Now the Cloud that He's coming is, if we just had the time to get this back, and get the real background and the whole thing.

Now the Cloud He's coming in is not a cloud, like a thunderhead,

[Brother Brian points to the Cloud picture] That is not a thunderhead. That was 30 miles high. There's no moisture to make a cloud 30 miles high. There's no oxygen. There's no H2O, and no oxygen to make that cloud. Yet the naysayers will look at another cloud that was only 4 miles up, and they'll say, oh, That was a missile, so the cloud was a missile. There were two clouds.

There are always twins. Cain and Abel, Esau and Jacob. You know, there's always twins, okay? Even Christ, the tree of life, and the devil, the tree of knowledge, of good and evil, so there's always twins, Jesus and Judas. Everything else, all right? So he says,

but it's a Cloud of Glory He's coming in. See? Now, when Jesus was overshadowed by God on Mount Transfiguration, Clouds over shadowed Him and His raiment. See?

And when Elijah would come down, a cloud come down and received him up, not a not a thunderhead, but a Cloud of Glory. His great glorious Presence will strike the earth. He cometh in Clouds! Oh, I love that.

Clouds, there'll be wave after wave of His Glory will come across the earth - and the resurrection of the saints shall come.

Now, when I looked at that picture and a brother from Oregon, Brother Bill Caldwell, had gone down in 1967, I think it was, when he came in the message, and he saw the cloud.

So he went down and talked to Doctor McDonald's, who did all the research on it. And Doctor McDonald also said there are two clouds, in his studies.

But the naysayers don't want to look at that, because they're the other side of the twin recipe. But anyway, so he went down, and he got an original copy. It was an original. So it wasn't, like a print after print after print. And everything's faded out.

He got an original, I should say an original print. And he took a magnifying glass to it. Just felt led to, and you could see about a million or more faces in the cloud. I won't know nobody in the generation before me or the generation after me. (neither will you) I'll know those in the generation with me. Every generation will come successfully right as it went down.

They which were last (That's the omega.) will be first. Sure, that's me. See? I'll know my people, the next time my dad and his people, my grandfather and his people, on down like that, wave after wave after wave after wave.

So each generation that went down comes up. But the last one comes up first. Then the father, then the grandfather, then the grandfather, all the way back to the garden.

And the saints will rise from everywhere. Won't that be wonderful, Amen. That makes the old people feel young again, yes.

Now notice closely, for **I come to you in a Cloud, and every eye shall see Him**, no matter how far back they died, they'll see Him.

Now from quotations on how can you, no matter how far back you died, how can you see them? Now? Just think about that, because the brother read a couple quotes where Brother Branham said, we'll see brother so and so and sister so and so. How are you going to see them? How are these people that are died in the grave going to see them? Because it's another dimension. We're talking about a dimensional thing here.

Quotation for Question No. 3: Q and A 54-0103E 143-191 What you are here... Get this in your mind now. I'm going to close. But what you are here is a sign that you are something else somewhere.

You've always wanted to be in perfection, you Christians. There is a perfection, and that perfection is not in this life.

Question No. 3: A) What did he mean by there is a perfection, and that perfection is not in this life, when it's written in Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

Well, we could go on with hundreds of scriptures. You know, "it's not him that runneth or him that willeth, but God that showeth mercy". Right? And it's nothing we have done, it's what He's done for us. So we can't look at this. Be ye therefore perfect as your Father in heaven is perfect, as if it's something you can do, but it's something He has done.

Answer to Question No. 3A) There is no perfection on this side of the resurrection as long as we live in the body of this death. But Perfection is as God knew us in His mind before the foundations of the World. And that could only come through a perfect oncefor-all sacrifice.

So, when God looks down at the Christian who is alive in Christ, and has died to himself, and is raised in newness of Life, He looks through the blood of His son, and He sees you as perfect as he saw His son. If you walk in the light as He is in the light.

Now, the Pillar of Fire is not God. The Pillar of Fire is a clothing that God wore. He comes down wearing a garment of light. Right? And also it says His garment is a cloud. So if you walk in the light as He's in the light, then the blood of Jesus Christ cleanses you from all sin. That was Jesus' commandment.

Hebrews Chapter 5 and 6 57-0908M P:37 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect. (That was Jesus' commandment.) Be ye so... They say, "Nobody can be perfect; the Bible said there is none perfect. There's your contradiction." Is it?

All right, you cannot be perfect in yourself. If you're trusting in what you done, you're lost. So be ye perfect, even just as perfect as God is perfect. Now. Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father... in heaven is perfect.

Therefore ... Now, the 5th chapter-6th chapter of **Hebrews**... Therefore Leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on to perfection;...

Ok, we know we worship a Father God who is perfect, and we are to be Perfect as He is perfect, and the only way is through a perfect Word. When God sees the body of Christ he sees you as perfect as the Head of the body which is Christ. He sees you as perfect as He saw the head of that body, which is Christ, because we're part of the same body.

Water of Separation 55-0121 P:14 God looking through the Blood, He doesn't see you no more as a sinner, Hallelujah. He sees you redeemed. Amen. You're redeemed because He only sees you through Christ. I just wish that we could look at one another as God looks at one another and see you as perfect as God sees you.

Now, that's the reason we can be perfect. Not perfect in the sense of sinless, we're perfect in the eyes of God when we're in Christ.

That's the reason He said, "Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father in heaven is perfect."

So when you look at a person and you say, I know that person is a Christian. They live their life for Christ. They go all over the world, they do things for Christ. Right? And then you say, well, but he's not much of a person. I don't like the person. Well, you know what? Forget it. That's not what's saved. It's a soul that's saved. All right.

Get your eyes off the flesh. Get your eyes on the God who created us, and we were in Him before the foundations of the world. Think of that person as being in what they were before the foundations of the world, because that's the way they're going to be. Well, that's the reason he said, be therefore perfect, even as your Father in heaven is perfect.

Paul in the 10th chapter of Hebrews trying to explain the law having a shadow of good things to come, not the very image of the things could never make the comer unto perfect, because God was looking through animal blood.

But now He looks through the Blood of His Son. Perfection comes by Jesus Christ. Now, I'm not perfect in your sight. You may not be perfect in my sight. But what about in God's sight? There's where it lays.

And if you're borned again into the body of Christ, then God looks upon you as perfect as Christ was Himself. Amen. Nothing you can do; it's not by any works you can do at all.

It's by grace God has given you this offer, and if you've accepted it, in the sight of God you are perfect, redeemed, washed in the Blood of the Lamb, Without fault, without blemish, without spot. Isn't that marvelous?

See? "Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father in heaven is perfect." See? "Be ye therefore perfect." How can you be perfect? Not in yourself, but in Him. He's the One perfect. And if you're in Him, you're perfect.

God doesn't look at you then; He looks at Him.

Well, you say, "I'm in Him." How do you get in Him? By one Spirit we're all baptized into one Body, and then you're in Him, when you're baptized by the Holy Spirit into the Body: I Corinthians 12. Is that true? Then in Him...

Law having a shadow 56-0621 P:27 Those sacrifices which were offered year by year never made to comer unto perfect. Jesus in Saint Matthew's Gospel said, "Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father in heaven is perfect." How you going to do it? How can you do it?

How can you be as perfect as God is perfect? But that was a commission, or a commandment by Jesus Christ, to be as perfect as God is in heaven, perfect. Then you say, "Who can be saved?"

Hold it just a moment. Let's find out how that perfection is made. Now, God, back there in the beginning, when He foresaw down through this streak of time, and He knew they would have to have a remedy to save those which was desiring to be saved...

Question No. 3B) Hebrews 11: 40 God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

What does he mean by **some better thing for us**? **without us**, what is the link between us and them?

Answer to Questions 3C and 3D: Paul is talking about the Old Testament saints who could not be perfected through the blood of bulls and goats, but by a once-for-all perfect sacrifice, God perfected us forever through Jesus Christ.

The better thing is the once-for-all sacrifice instead of a yearly offering of bulls and goats. The link between us and them is the resurrection in Christ. They have to have this Message to come into the presence of Christ.

Quote for No. 4: Who is this Melchisedec 65-0221E P:47 II Thessalonians tells us so: "For we which are alive and remain shall not prevent (or hinder) those which are asleep; for the trumpet of God shall sound; the dead in Christ shall rise first; we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them to meet the Lord in the air."

Perfect, all these types...Therefore the theophany, if you have died and entered into that theophany, what happens? The theophany comes to the earth to pick up the redeemed body. And if you're here in the air, you take the body to meet the theophany (There you are,) and caught up and go to meet the Lord in the air. Who is this Melchisedec but God?

Question No. 4A: The theophany comes to the earth to pick up the redeemed body, is this concerning the resurrection and the tent?

Answer to 4A: Yes, there will be a change of the body in that little room in the tent during the time of the resurrection.

Question for 4B: If you're here in the air, you take the body to meet the theophany, is this about the living, if so, is this taking place after they've already been changed, because it said if you're here in the air.

Answer to 4B: Of course, we get our change and our theophany which is the God-body which we bypassed to come here and be tried and tested, we must have the change of the body to receive it.

Paul called it a celestial body. But he said our earthly body shall put on the celestial in the resurrection. So, we go from one to the other, and the earthly body gets its change.

Question for 4C: Is there a link between these two-side event with the tent?

Answer for 4C: I do not know, I will wait until God brings it to pass, that way He has confirmed His Word to us. We shall wait and see. We know there are three events. The Bible says so and William Branham prophet of God told us so.

The Shout which is the Message. The Voice which is the Resurrection and change of the body. That looks like two events, but it's actually part of the resurrection.

So that appears to be one event. And the Trump of God which is our call to the wedding supper. So don't ask me to define the one event. And we know that there's two things happening, but don't ask me to tell you the timing of those, I just don't know. I'm waiting for it, and of course, the Trump is a wedding supper.

Question number 5: According to some reports, the United States House of Representatives approved a bill to adopt a definition of anti-Semitism that includes the claim that Jews were involved in the execution of Jesus Christ. A team of Catholic, Protestant and Jewish scholars have begun working on a new joint translation of the Scriptures that could be the long-awaited canon of the Bible.

47 There are other things here that I would like to study a little before making the announcement. In other words, I really don't know yet. And I'm not going to say nothing until I really, know that's what he's saying there.

I would like to study a little before making the announcement.

In other words, you see exactly what we're talking about, which is exactly what the Scripture says will happen in these days, that these things will come together and form an image to the beast, exactly.

They've made the attempt and they're working on it, (What year was this? This was 1960. Okay. And he says,) They've made the attempt and they're working on it, and now they have the best opportunity they've ever had to present it, because it's right there in their hands. And for that same reason I am bringing these prophetic messages, because I believe they are timely.

So my **Answer No. 5 is:** There have been a whole lot of Bible translations since 1960. The one that the Catholics and Protestants share is the Jerusalem Bible and the New Jerusalem Bible, since it also uses the word Yahweh instead of the word Lord, which the King James Version uses, I think 6800+ times. I think they had help with Jewish scholars in writing and also because they've changed the words. And it talks about the ... I can't even pronounce the Jewish word, but it's Tetragrammaton or something like that. Anyway, so they had help with the Hebrew. Okay, so I think this is what he's talking about. But you know what? I wasn't there. I don't know. And I didn't contact the person that wrote the article. So I have no idea. But in 1985, the Catholic English version translation of the Bible, it's the New Jerusalem Bible.

The NJB is an English translation of the Bible published in 1985 by Darton, Longman, and Todd and Les Editions du Cerf, whatever that means. Edited by benedictine biblical scholars, (as catholic scholars), biblical scholars, Henry Wansbrough, and approved for use in study and personal devotion by members of the Catholic Church, but is used by the Church of England also.

So you see, they did do a translation together. Now, these other translations since 1965.

They include the following:

- The New American Standard Bible (NASB) was published in 1971, with subsequent revisions in 1995 and 2020.
- The New International Version (NIV) was first published in 1978, with subsequent revisions in 1984, 2011, and 2018.
- The English Standard Version (ESV) was published in 2001.

- The Holman Christian Standard Bible (HCSB) was published in 1999.
- The New English Translation (NET) was published in 2005.
- The Common English Bible (CEB) was published in 2011.
- The Christian Standard Bible (CSB) was published in 2017.

Well, there was also, Jimmy Swaggart, he had his own Bible. A study Bible he called it, the Expository Bible. And there's also another expositor Bible that was written by Nelson.

But in Jimmy Swaggart's, instead of putting his footnotes on the side, he actually incorporates them into scripture. And then he puts his words in red and everything else in the Bible in black.

So, you know, at least we put all of God's word in red, Brother Branham's in blue, and then ours in black. But he just felt he could usurp God, I think. Because he actually stated, I saw this sermon, he said that predestination is a lie from the pits of hell. Well, you know the man then, he knows that he's predestinated to the other side, to say something like that. So Billy said, well, just tell him we're denomination. I said, how can I do that? Well, they're doing it up in Lima. I said, then Lima is going to be responsible, because at the White Throne, they're going to have to answer, why did you say you were denomination?

Why did you sign this application for healthcare that says, we believe in the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost? I wouldn't even do that in homeschooling.

When we home schooled our kids, they say, oh, it's just a piece of paper. It's not just a piece of paper. It's your written signature that's going to be brought up at the White Throne.

But just don't join up with them organizations, (How do you do that, you sign,) because one day I'll be telling you and prove it by the Scripture; it is the mark of the beast.
