

Revelation and Faith

In Acts 3:16 when Peter was asked how the mighty miracle had taken place upon the crippled one at the Gate Beautiful, he explained it on this wise,

“And His (Jesus) Name through faith in His (Jesus) Name hath made this man (former cripple) strong, yea the faith which is by (from) Him (Jesus) hath given him (the man) this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.”

See, there it is. Jesus' Name, and Jesus' Faith brought about the miracle. Peter did not claim it was his own **human faith** any more than he claimed that

it was **his own name**. He said that Jesus' Name used in the faith which is from Jesus performed that great work. This faith is what the Lord was speaking about

in Revelation 2:13. It was HIS faith. It was not faith IN Him. But it was HIS OWN faith that He had given to the believers. Romans 12:3, “**According as God**

hath dealt to every man” (according to verse 1 the men are BRETHREN) “the measure of faith.”

Ephesians 2:8, “By grace are ye saved through faith; and that (Faith) not of yourself: it is a gift of God.”

And it also says in James 2:1, “My brethren,” (notice

he, too, is talking to BRETHREN), “have not the faith OF (not in) our Lord Jesus Christ with respect of persons.”

An Exposition Of The Seven Church Ages - 5 - The Pergamean Church Age

Ephesians 4:4-6 4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism,

6 One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

The church, too, has departed from what she originally was. She is a hybrid. That is, the church **nominal** is a hybrid. People say, “I am a Baptist.”

It wasn't so in the beginning. “I am Methodist.” It wasn't so in the beginning. **Instead of the straight Word of God**, instead of the Spirit-filled men in the

church who were led by Spirit-given revelation, there are now creeds, and by-laws, and the educated guesses of educated men. **Learning** has

taken the place of **revelation**. **Reason** has replaced **faith**. Program has replaced spontaneous praise in the Holy Ghost. It wasn't so from the beginning. The

whole specie has changed. It has become a hybrid church. Now then, when the church becomes hybridized, will it produce pure Christians? **It can't**.

The life or seed that brings Christians to birth is not in them. Like brings forth like. The Baptists bring forth more Baptists and they act like Baptists.

Methodists bring forth Methodists and they act like Methodists. Not one is known by the power of God nor can they be for it's not there. They are known by

their ceremonial worship of God and their creeds and dogmas.

And the so called Believers produce more So Called Believers

The importance of revelation by the Spirit to a true believer can never be **over emphasized**. Revelation means more to you than perhaps you realize.

Now I am not talking about this Book of Revelation and you. I am talking about ALL revelation. It is tremendously important to the church.

Do you remember in Matthew 16 where Jesus asked the disciples this question, “Whom do men say that I the Son of Man am?”

And they said, Some say that Thou art John the Baptist: some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets. He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am?

And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou,

Simon Bar-jona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but My Father Which is in heaven. And I say unto thee, that thou art Peter, and

upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it”? The Roman Catholics say that the church is built upon Peter.

Now that is really carnal. How could God build the church upon a man so unstable that he denied the Lord Jesus and cursed while doing it?

God can't build His church upon any man born in sin. And it wasn't some rock lying there as though God had hallowed the ground at that spot.

And it **isn't** as the Protestants say, that the church is built upon Jesus. It was the REVELATION. Read it the way it is written:

“Flesh and blood hath not REVEALED it, BUT MY FATHER HATH REVEALED IT, and UPON THIS ROCK (REVELATION) I WILL BUILD MY CHURCH.”

The church is built on Revelation, on the “**Thus Saith the Lord.**” How did Abel know what to do in order to offer a proper sacrifice to God?

By **faith** he received the revelation of the blood. Cain didn't get such a revelation (even though he

had a commandment) so he couldn't offer the right sacrifice. It was a revelation from God that made the difference and gave Abel eternal life. Now you might

take what the pastor says, or what the seminary teaches, and though it might be taught to you with eloquence, until God reveals to you that Jesus is the

Christ, and that it is the blood that cleanses you, and that God is your Saviour, you will never have eternal life. It is the Spiritual revelation that does it.

An Exposition Of The Seven Church Ages - 1 - The Revelation Of Jesus Christ

82 Cain was just as religious as Abel was. They both built altars. They both loved God. They both made sacrifices. They both worshipped. They both paid

tithe. They both done everything just alike. But Abel, by faith which is "the revelation," the Word of God revealed, made plain, showed out, and vindicated.

Glory! Cain made an offering, but God didn't vindicate it. God required worship, and Cain made the offering, but God didn't vindicate it. But by the true channel...

83 You say, “Well, my church is it. My...”

84 Wait just a minute. **God interprets His Own Word** by Its terms that He spoke in. See, Cain said, “I am religious. I am a lover of my Maker. I offer to

Thee this fine altar. I offer to You this sacrifice. I built all these things up, Lord, because I love You.” Abel said the same thing. Now, it’s the one that’s

vindicated, the one that’s proven. And God come down and received Abel’s sacrifice, because by **revelation** he had struck the true channel of God that was accepted.

65-1128M - God's Only Provided Place Of Worship

Why is it so hard for People to just worship God the way he Ask to be Worshiped, NO its got to be of My own Will and Idea,

174 Her eyes had seen beyond his criticism. She believed He was, see, the Word of the prophets. She knowed that That was all the Words of the prophets,

was vindicated in Him. She had heard He was on earth, but now she sees Him. Watch what she done. She seen the Word made flesh, the Messiah, the

Emmanuel. When she gave vent to her pulsation of faith (**of revelation of Who He was**, in the time she was living, that He was God's Lamb for such sinners as she was), she went forth to serve His needs without knowing how she would do it.

175 That's the way a **genuine** healing comes, when it's revealed to you that **"He was wounded for your transgressions, bruised for your iniquity, and with His stripes you were healed."**

When it's inspired to you to see His Presence here, of Saint Mark 11, or, Saint Luke 17:30, that He's going to reveal Himself in the last days (among His

people, in human flesh) like He did before Sodom. When you see that, and something strikes you!

65-1127E - I Have Heard But Now I See

75 Now, that's the way every believer, no matter how bad the cancer's got you, how long you been setting in a wheelchair, any of those things, just if you can

grasp that revelation from God! Then be satisfied, knowing that it's going to happen, because **faith** waits patiently for the promise. See?

65-1127E - I Have Heard But Now I See

70 So, Job, checking himself with the genuine faith that God had give to him that he was “**just,**” that he had done everything that God required him to do.

Now when we’re going to be prayed for, for our sickness, I wonder if we have done everything that God requires us to do. Have we followed every iota

of the Scripture? Have we give Him our hearts and lives to service? What’s the reason you want to be healed? That’s the reason you can’t get faith

enough, see, because you haven’t maybe made this thing to God sincerely from your heart. Like Hezekiah did, give God the reason, he wanted to set

his—his kingdom in order. And God sent His prophet back and told him, and he’d be healed. See? But, you have to have those things made right, first.

71 So then as soon as you get to these places and know that it’s been **revealed** to you by the Word of God, by the revelation, by the Word that God requires you to do, then you have faith, **genuine faith.**

55 You see, when a man or a person has once really come in contact with God, with that genuine, **revealed faith** that “**God is!**” There’s nothing, no

time, nowhere, can ever separate that man from his God. I believe it was Paul said, “**There’s no strife, no hunger, no perils, neither living creatures, or death,**

or anything that can separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus.” You are securely anchored in Him because you were **ordained** to that Life.

56 But Satan thought he could twist him around a little bit, and cuff him up, and make him do it. But, you see, Job with his **perfect** revelation of God, and

Be Still and Know that I am God,(Psalm 46:10)

Who God was, and how God loved him, **he waited!** No matter what the circumstances was, **he waited for his faith to be confirmed,** because he had had a grip on God, a revelation. That I spoke of last night.

57 Now, when the sick people that's in the building, the crippled people, or you that have a need of God, when you can get that type of a revelation that you

are **“justified,”** when you are actually justified in asking the thing that you're asking for, and believe that **“He is a Rewarder of those that diligently seek**

after Him,” there's nothing can ever separate you from **that faith** that's anchored to you. See? But, first, **it has to be revealed to you.**

311 Then, the works that the Holy Spirit is doing today, by these visions never failing, promises never failing, all the apostolic signs promised in the Bible,

of Malachi 4, and, oh, the Revelation 10:7, all of that is being fulfilled; and proved by scientific, every other way. And if I haven't told you the Truth, these

“There’s One standing among you now, Who you know not, and I’m not worthy to loose the latches on His shoes, but He’ll baptize you with the Holy Ghost. And He’s right among you now.”

He expressed it, his faith, because he knowed, in his day, he was to see and baptize God’s Messiah. So, you see, the people could see the expression upon

him, in the way he was preaching and the way he was acting, was expressing that he had a true revelation from God.

176 And if God would just spoke that, right down in your heart tonight, said “You’re not going to be laying

in that bed. You're not going to be setting in that chair. You're going to be well," there couldn't be anything change your mind in it.

177 But until that's happened, every preacher in the world could pray,...I don't say it wouldn't help you; it would, it'd encourage you. **But until that faith...**

See, **the healing power is in you.** It don't come from the preacher. It comes to **you by revelation,** by faith. "**Not by power, not by might, but by My Spirit,**" saith the Lord.

"My Spirit, by grace, reveals this to you." And there's nothing can take it away. By faith, revelation! Then, David to prove his works,...

understand Who He is, or how It is, except it be revealed to you by the revelation of God. **And then faith in that,** you act accordingly. See? Here we see

plainly that God is revealed in Jesus, **and only those who were foreordained to see it,**

117 In a audience of people, where a prayer line comes through, you'll find some...and they were all good people, we'll say. There's some that's trying

hard to believe It, trying to work themselves into It. Some just can't do it at all. And others, it's just by grace, it's just given to them. Now, there is the

difference. See? That does it. That's the real revelation, **because faith is a revelation from God.** It must be revealed first. (you must accept it and confess it) 65-1126 - Works Is Faith Expressed

160 And the revelation is the only thing, the revelation of the Word. What is the...What is a revelation?

Jesus said, **“Upon this rock I'll build My Church, and the gates of hell can't prevail against It.”**

Faith is a revelation; because Faith has been revealed to you.

161 “Abel, by faith, offered by revelation (faith), offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than that of Cain.”

66 **Now, it is a revelation, for the revelation is faith.** You cannot have a revelation without it being faith. Faith is a revelation, because it's something

that's revealed to you. Faith is a revelation. Faith is something that has been revealed to you, like it was to Abraham, that could call anything contrary to what

had been revealed to him, as though it wasn't so. Now, faith, that's what faith is, **is the revelation of God.** The Church is built upon a revelation, the whole entire Body.

pomegranates or something that they eat in the garden of Eden, that caused sin. And he found Adam...or, I mean, Abel believed that it (he) it was

blood. Which, it really was. And Abel, by revelation, faith, offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than that of Cain; which God testified by it, he was

righteous. See? **And the whole Church is built upon a Divine revelation of the Word of God.** The whole...

Now All that God was he poured into Christ and All that Christ was He poured into the Church. Who Are We??

34 And Peter said, “Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.”

35 He said, “Blessed art thou, Simon, son of Jonas, flesh and blood never revealed this to you. You never learned this by going to a seminary. See, you

never learned this by some man-made affair. But My Father, which is in Heaven, has revealed this to you. See? Upon this rock I’ll build My Church, and the

gates of hell cannot prevail against It,” the spiritual revelation of Jesus Christ, Who is the Word. Then it would be the spiritual revealed Truth of the Word, is exactly where the Church rests.

165 Now that’s the question. Here is where I wanted to get to: In Revelation 10 (We’ll get to it in a few minutes, to another Scripture, refer.),

He said, “In the days of the Message of the seventh angel, the mystery of God ought to be finished.”

Here is the question, is, if you follow in that line in this hour, will it be finished? **“Will I find the Faith?”**
Will Malachi 4 be fulfilled in this time,

“Restore the Faith of the children, back to the Faith of the fathers, the original, the Word”? See?

1 Corinthians 11:23-34

23 For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, that the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

24 And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.

25 After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

26 For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.

33 Wherefore, my brethren, when ye come together to eat, tarry one for another.

34 And if any man hunger, let him eat at home; that ye come not together unto condemnation. And the rest will I set in order when I come.

Foot Washing

John 13

1 Now before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his

own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.

2 And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him;

3 Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;

4 He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself.

5 After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded.

6 Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet?

7 Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but thou shalt know hereafter.

8 Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me.

9 Simon Peter saith unto him, Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head.

10 Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash his feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.

11 For he knew who should betray him; therefore said he, Ye are not all clean.

12 So after he had washed their feet, and had taken his garments, and was set down again, he said unto them, Know ye what I have done to you?

13 Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.

14 If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

15 For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.

16 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him.

17 If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.

Amen,
